Sealed Bids will be received by the Marine City at City Hall, 303 S. Water St., Marine City, Michigan 48039 up to 2:00 p.m., prevailing local time, on March 1, 2018 and then publicly opened and read aloud for the construction of Contract 200-12779-17002.

The Work consists of all labor and material required for removing and replacing 160 feet of sewer within the North Mary Street right of way, and any work and materials needed to restore excavation area including, but not limited to, bituminous pavement, concrete walks, and grass restoration.

Bids shall be on a unit price basis with lump sum prices for certain items of the Work.

The Drawings and Project Manual under which the Work is to be done are on file and may be examined at City Hall, 303 S. Water St., Marine City, Michigan 48039, at the Department of Public Works, 514 S. Parker, Marine City, Michigan 48039, and at the office of the ENGINEER, Tetra Tech, Inc., 1005 River Street, Port Huron, Michigan 48060.

Bidding Documents may be obtained after January 17, 2018 by purchase from the ENGINEER for the sum of \$25 per set. Ground shipping with purchase is an additional \$10 per set. Priority overnight shipping with purchase is an additional \$20 per set. There will be no refunds or return of Bidding Documents. Direct the request, with payment, to the ENGINEER at 1005 River Street, Port Huron, Michigan 48060, (810) 956-9300. The purchaser must supply the telephone and facsimile numbers along with street address of the individual or firm to whom addenda (if any) can be directed.

A Bid Security in the form of a certified check, bank check, or Bid Bond for a sum not less than five percent (5%) of the amount of the Bid will be required with each Bid.

The right is reserved by OWNER to accept any Bid, to reject any Bid, and to waive irregularities in Bids.

OWNER will qualify Bidders for this Contract. The qualification documents are located in the Bidding Documents in Section 00110. Additional copies may be obtained from ENGINEER. All Bidders who are interested in submitting a Bid on this Contract must complete the qualification documents and submit them to OWNER along with Bid.

OWNER will not engage in unlawful discrimination on the basis of race, color, religion, national origin, age, sex, height, weight, marital status, or unrelated disability. Bids from minority- and female-owned organizations are encouraged.

No Bids may be withdrawn after the above date and time for receiving Bids for a period of sixty (60) days.
